#### SEIMAS EMBARKED ON DELIBERATIONS OF 2016 STATE BUDGET



On 20 October 2016, the Seimas started deliberating the draft Law on the Approval of the Financial Indicators of the 2016 State Budget and the Municipal Budgets (No. XIIP-3651), proposing to endorse the state budget revenue of nearly EUR 8.004 billion, representing a 0.2 % increase as compared to 2015, and to approve over EUR 8.655 billion in expenditure (budget appropriations exceed the revenue by EUR 651.5 million).

In 2016, the national budget, consisting of the state and municipal budgets, together with EU and other international funding of EUR 2.111

billion, is expected to receive nearly EUR 9.394 billion in revenue, which is a 1.3 % increase on the planned revenue in 2015, the appropriations amounting to EUR 10.045 billion.

### THE SEIMAS PROHIBITED PERSONS FOUND GUILTY OF CRIMINAL OFFENCES AGAINST SEXUAL SELF-DETERMINATION AND INTEGRITY OF CHILDREN FROM WORKING WITH THEM

At the plenary sitting on 20 October 2015, the Seimas adopted the amendments to the Law on Fundamentals of Protection of the Rights of the Child, aimed at preventing sexual offences against children. The new provisions were approved by 70 votes in favour, with no votes against and 3 abstentions.

The amendments provide that persons found guilty of criminal offences against sexual self-determination and integrity of children, including sexual abuse, using a child for pornography, and purchase or sale of a child, are banned from working with children in the future. These persons will be prohibited from working or volunteering for institutions, companies and organisations providing social, educational, sports, and health care services for children.

#### GEDIMINAS KIRKILAS, CHAIR OF THE COMMITTEE ON EUROPEAN AFFAIRS: THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION NEEDS A SPECIAL POST OR BODY FOR REFUGEES

"The European Commission should have a special post or body for refugee matters. The refugee problem is a complex one and requires a single authority to coordinate the entire policy. It could either take the form of a portfolio in the European Commission or be a temporary institution whenever necessary. Most importantly, we should protect European solidarity and Lithuania has already made its decision. However, the European Union (EU) cannot merely focus on burning issues, but must look forward and find solutions to the refugee crisis," said Gediminas Kirkilas, Deputy Speaker of the Seimas and Chair of the Committee on European Affairs, at the meetings on 5 October, where the Committee and the Committee on Foreign Affairs met with the delegations of Swedish and German parliaments.

### MEMBER OF THE SEIMAS PAVILIONIENĖ: WOMEN PARLIAMENTARIANS AND THE SWEDISH MINISTER DISCUSSED THE SITUATION OF WOMEN IN LITHUANIA



In a meeting on 8 October 2015, members of the Seimas, Marija Aušrinė Pavilionienė, Giedrė Purvaneckienė and Dalia Kuodytė, and the Swedish Minister for Foreign Affairs, Margo Wallström, discussed the legal situation of women in Lithuania, achievement of gender equality in the labour market and opportunities for international cooperation in addressing women's issues.

Ms Pavilionienė stressed that after Lithuania's accession to the European Union the focus on gender equality was much narrower than before. Moreover, the legislation promoting gender equality was being blocked at the Seimas, whereas initiatives aggravating the situation

were welcomed. Marija Aušrinė Pavilionienė also noted that Lithuania had not yet adopted laws on reproductive health and artificial insemination and could offer no high quality sex education. "The lack of such laws and programmes has a negative influence on girls' and women's health and on the prevention of trafficking in human beings," the member of the Seimas said during the meeting.

On 16 October 2015, Members of the Seimas Committee on European Affairs and Committee on Economics met with Violeta Bulc, Commissioner for Transport. The aim of the meeting was to discuss EU transport policy issues important for Lithuania, with greater focus on the progress of the Rail Baltica project. Committee members also drew the Commissioner's attention to the problems emerging in the Lithuanian transport sector due to the minimum hourly wage requirement applied in Germany; inconsistent transposition of EU legal norms into national law; weekly rest period requirements in Belgium and France; and the issues related to Italy's requirements to submit special permits for carriers transporting goods from/to third countries.
