

SEIMAS OF THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA COMMITTEE ON FOREIGN AFFAIRS

STATEMENT ON ATTACKS BY THE TERRORIST ORGANISATION HAMAS AGAINST THE STATE OF ISRAEL

13 May 2021 Vilnius

The Committee on Foreign Affairs of the Seimas of the Republic of Lithuania,

deeply shocked by the recent rocket strikes on the territory between the State of Israel and the Gaza Strip, leading, among other things, to civilian casualties,

expressing its sincere condolences to the families and close ones of the victims,

regrets the fact that both sides have launched military operations, which might make the situation unpredictable;

expresses its concern over the ominous escalation of the situation between Israelis and Palestinians as since 10 May 2021 the terrorist organisation Hamas, backed by the Iranian ayatollah regime, has launched hundreds of rockets from the Gaza Strip, which is only 70 kilometres away from Tel Aviv, into almost every Israeli city;

condemns the rocket attacks deliberately targeted by the terrorist organisation Hamas against the civilian population of Israel;

notes that the State of Israel, where various nationalities live in democracy, has the right to defend itself against any attack or terror aimed exclusively at the civilian population;

calls on the international community to exercise it political leverage to force the terrorist organisation Hamas to cease the violence and killings of Israeli civilians;

reminds that the Iran-backed Islamist movement Hamas, which controls the Gaza Strip, has been recognised as a terrorist organisation by the European Union;

invites Israeli and Palestinian negotiators to resolve the conflict peacefully at the negotiating table in good faith and mutual respect; political, religious and community leaders on both sides should, without delay, make every responsible effort to put an end to bloodshed.
