### Seimas approved the Government Annual Performance Report

On 10 April 2010, Prime Minister Saulius Skvernelis submitted the Government Annual Performance Report to the Seimas\*. The Report highlights that the year 2017 was particularly successful for the Lithuanian economy. Moreover, the tasks and structural reforms (in taxation, innovation, education, health, pension system and reduction of the new shadow economy) planned by the Government for 2018 will significantly contribute to a better quality of life of each person in Lithuania.

The Prime Minister stated that in the previous year particular attention had been given to the fight against poverty and material inequality, with over EUR 600 million being used for tackling these problems. "It was the first time that a political decision was taken to universally pay the child allowance, otherwise called the child's money. [...] In 2017, as compared to 2016, the number of recipients of child allowances increased by about 81 % boosting the related expenditure by approximately 63 %. The forecast is that this year around 400 thousand children will receive the child's money, and the amount paid will double as compared to the amount previously paid through additional income tax exemptions," said the Prime Minister. He spoke about the plans to progressively increase the child's money every year, and, from the next year onwards, to make a growth in income felt even by better earning residents who raise children.

# Committee on European Affairs: decommissioning of the Ignalina NPP is a high added value EU project



At its meeting with a delegation of the Committee on Budgetary Control of the European Parliament on 6 April 2018, the Committee on European Affairs discussed the course of developments in the decommissioning projects of the Ignalina Nuclear Power Plant (NPP). Members of the Committee on European Affairs and chairs of other Seimas committees stressed the progress achieved in implementing the projects in the Ignalina NPP and their importance for the national security of Lithuania and for the security of the whole European Union.

It was the second time that a delegation composed of members of the Committee on Budgetary Control of the European Parliament, the European Commission and the Court of Auditors and lead by Ingeborg Gräßle, Chair of the Committee on Budgetary Control, visited Lithuania. The main purpose of the visit was to learn about the progress of the Ignalina NPP decommissioning processes in preparation for the decision-making on the Union's post-2020 budget, including further funding of the decommissioning of the Ignalina NPP.


Committee on Foreign Affairs: reinforced attention to creating a secure neighbourhood for the EU should be maintained in the debate on the new EU Multiannual Financial Framework

At its closed sitting on 11 April 2018, the Seimas Committee on Foreign Affairs discussed the funding of the EU's external action in the new EU Multiannual Financial Framework for 2021–2027 and the financial aspects of strengthening of the European Neighbourhood Policy both in the East and the South.

By consensus, the Committee adopted the Opinion on Financing of the European Neighbourhood Policy in the New Multiannual Financial Framework of the European Union (2021–2027), highlighting herein that the EU needs to be an effective global player, speak with one voice and focus its resources on strategic priorities, one of which notably being a secure neighbourhood.

On 10 April 2018, by observing a minute of silence at its sitting, the Seimas paid tribute to the memory of the Polish President Lech Kaczyński and other Polish citizens who died in an air crash eight years ago.

Viktoras Pranckietis, Speaker of the Seimas, said that the entire Europe had been shocked by the Smolensk tragedy that had claimed the lives of nearly a hundred people, including Prof. Lech Kaczyński, Polish President and Lithuania's good friend.

"I often wonder why this happened and why such brilliant people fell prey to such a meaningless death. I have no answer. There are no right words to describe what it felt for the Polish people at the time to lay their leader to rest. Warsaw was drowning in tears and flowers. So was Vilnius. Crowds were gathering to offer condolences to our Polish friends, which was testimony to our fraternity," said Mr Pranckietis.

reform will increase the trust of international partners and donors in Ukraine, improve credit ratings, lower the borrowing costs and promote investment.




