

PRIVACY NOTICE PARTICIPATION IN SOCIAL MEDIA

This privacy notice shall be addressed to persons (or their representatives) who follow or otherwise use information on social media accounts managed by the Office of the Seimas. When processing personal data, described in this notice, the Office of the Seimas shall act as the data controller. Social media outlets act as individual controllers of the personal data processed. When you log into these outlets, they process your personal data in accordance with their policy. We encourage you to learn about the privacy policy of the social media outlets and how your data is processed. PURPOSE
(Why do we use your data?)

We process personal data in order to properly inform you about the activities of the Seimas. Social media is only one of the channels for sharing information with citizens. The information is also available on the website of the Seimas; therefore, in order to learn about the activities of the Seimas, you do not have to log into to the social media outlets.

The Seimas shall process your personal data when you voluntarily log into the corresponding social media outlet, each applying its own conditions.

We process your personal data for statistical purposes and to make sure that communication with citizens is efficient.

CONDITION FOR LAWFUL PROCESSING
(On what basis do we process your data?)

Article 6(1) e of the GDPR (where processing of personal data is necessary for the performance of the task assigned to us in the public interest, which is laid down in the Statute of the Seimas, the Regulations of the Office of the Seimas, the Regulation of the Office of the Seimas and the Regulations of the Press Office).

Only special categories of data which have been explicitly made public by the data subject (Article 9 (2) (e) of the GDPR) shall be processed.

PERSONAL DATA
(What personal data are processed?)

GENERAL DATA

For statistical and analytical purposes, we only use the aggregated data on our accounts provided by social media outlets (number of likes, shares, comments, video views, and clicks).

Depending on the social media outlet, different types of personal data can be accessed:

1. Data to be provided.

Identity data: first name and surname, user name, user identity, geographical area, age, gender and other personal information such as family status or nationality provided to the media outlet by the user.

Professional experience and education: work, professional career, education.

2. Data to be monitored.

Personal information on users of social media outlets accessible through their networks and logging in: consumer involvement, accessibility and status, comments, sharing and other actions related to a specific topic, media and connections.

Personal data, accessible via audio and video content made available on social media platforms shall contain the following: the information the user indicates in the content created by him or information about this content (metadata), such as the location where the photo was taken or the date when the file was created, audio recordings, video recordings or the image of the data subject.

3. Personal data of special categories.

Data revealing racial or ethnic origin, political views, religious or philosophical beliefs or trade union membership, if the user has decided to make this public.

SOURCE OF DATA (Where do we get your data?)	The Office of the Seimas obtains your personal data directly from you.
ACCESS TO DATA (Who will have access to your data?)	Your data can be accessed by administrators of social media outlets where Seimas has accounts. For more information on how your data are managed by companies, managing social media outlets, please refer to the above indicated references to the policy of these outlets.
STORAGE PERIOD (How long will we store your data?)	No personal data shall be stored. The Office of the Seimas may not link the aggregated data with the data subject. The Office of the Seimas will store only generalised and numerical values in order to compare efficiency.
EXERCISE OF DATA SUBJECTS' RIGHTS (What are your rights and how can you exercise them?)	<p>As a data subject, you have the right to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• right to information on data processing (Articles 13 and 14 of the GDPR);• right to access the data (Article 15 of the GDPR);• right to rectification (Article 16 of the GDPR);• right to request erasure ('right to be forgotten') (Article 17 of the GDPR). Note: This right may be exercised provided at least one of the conditions set out in Article 17(1) of the GDPR is fulfilled;• right to restrict data processing (Article 18 of the GDPR). Note: This right may be exercised provided at least one of the conditions set out in Article 18(1) of the GDPR is fulfilled;• right to object to your personal data processing (Article 21 of the GDPR). Note: In this case, you should indicate for what specific reasons you wish to exercise these rights (only applicable where data are processed in accordance with Article 6(1)(e) and (f) of the GDPR). <p>All data processing issues should be addressed directly to the relevant social media outlet: <i>Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, LinkedIn, YouTube, Flickr</i>.</p> <p>The Seimas has accounts on <i>Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, LinkedIn, YouTube</i> and <i>Flickr</i>. Before going to the Seimas account on the above-mentioned social media outlets, you will have to agree or disagree with the policy of the relevant social media.</p> <p>Regarding the procedure for exercising the rights of data subjects, please contact the Data Protection Officer by using the contact details indicated above.</p>
SUBMISSION OF COMPLAINTS	Please be informed that you are entitled to complain to the State Data Protection Inspectorate and the court over the action/omission of the Office of the Seimas in

You do not have to provide personal data and you may not want use social networks; however, in this case, you will be able to find the information about the activities of the Seimas on the website of the Seimas rather than in social networks.

Please be informed that your data will not be used for making decisions concerning yourself based on automated data processing, including profiling. Please refer to the social media privacy policy indicate above to learn about the use of data by social media administrators.
