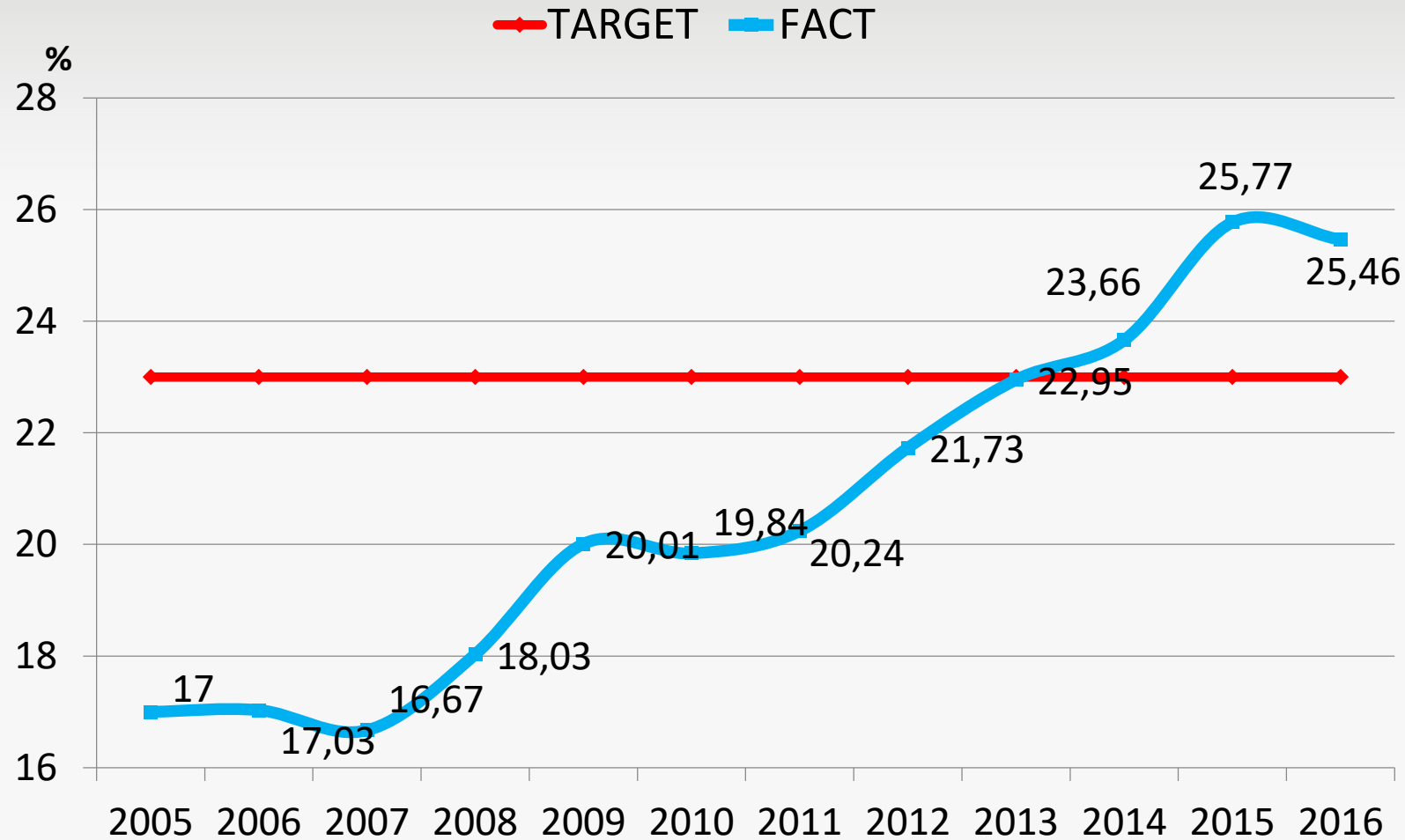

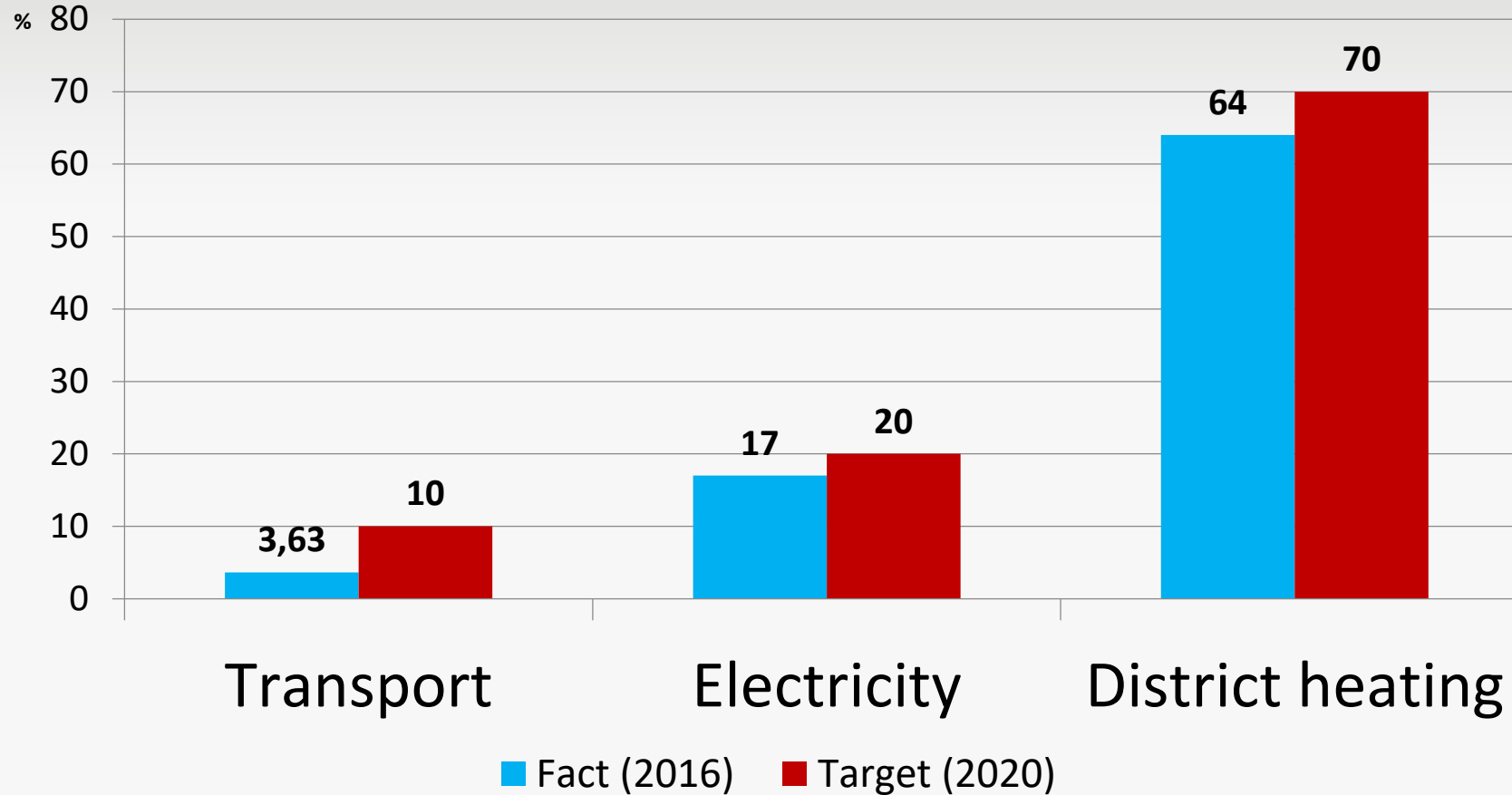

# RENEWABLE ENERGY IN FINAL ENERGY CONSUMPTION



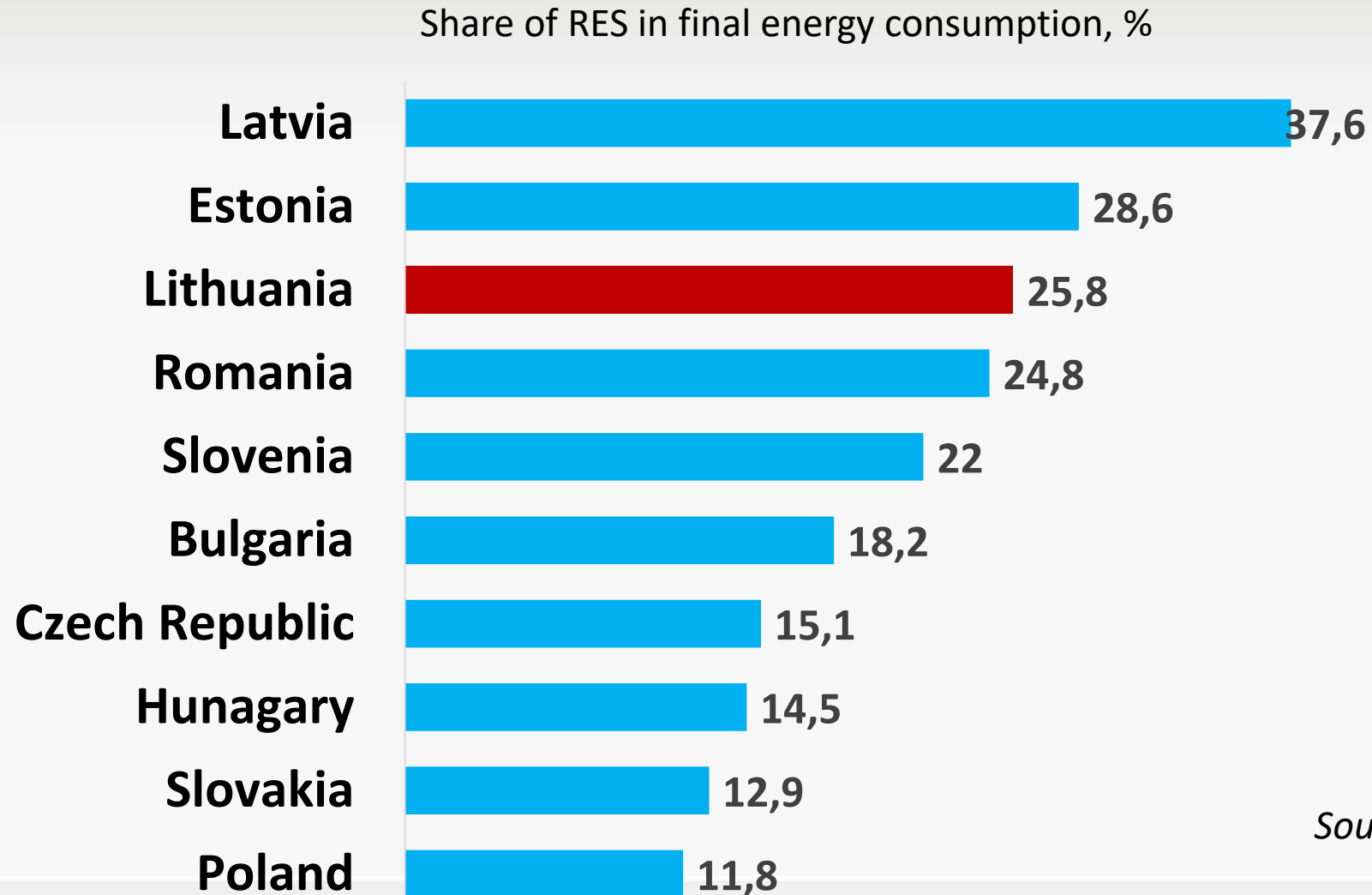

## ONE OF THE LEADERS IN CEE BY SUSTAINABLE ENERGY

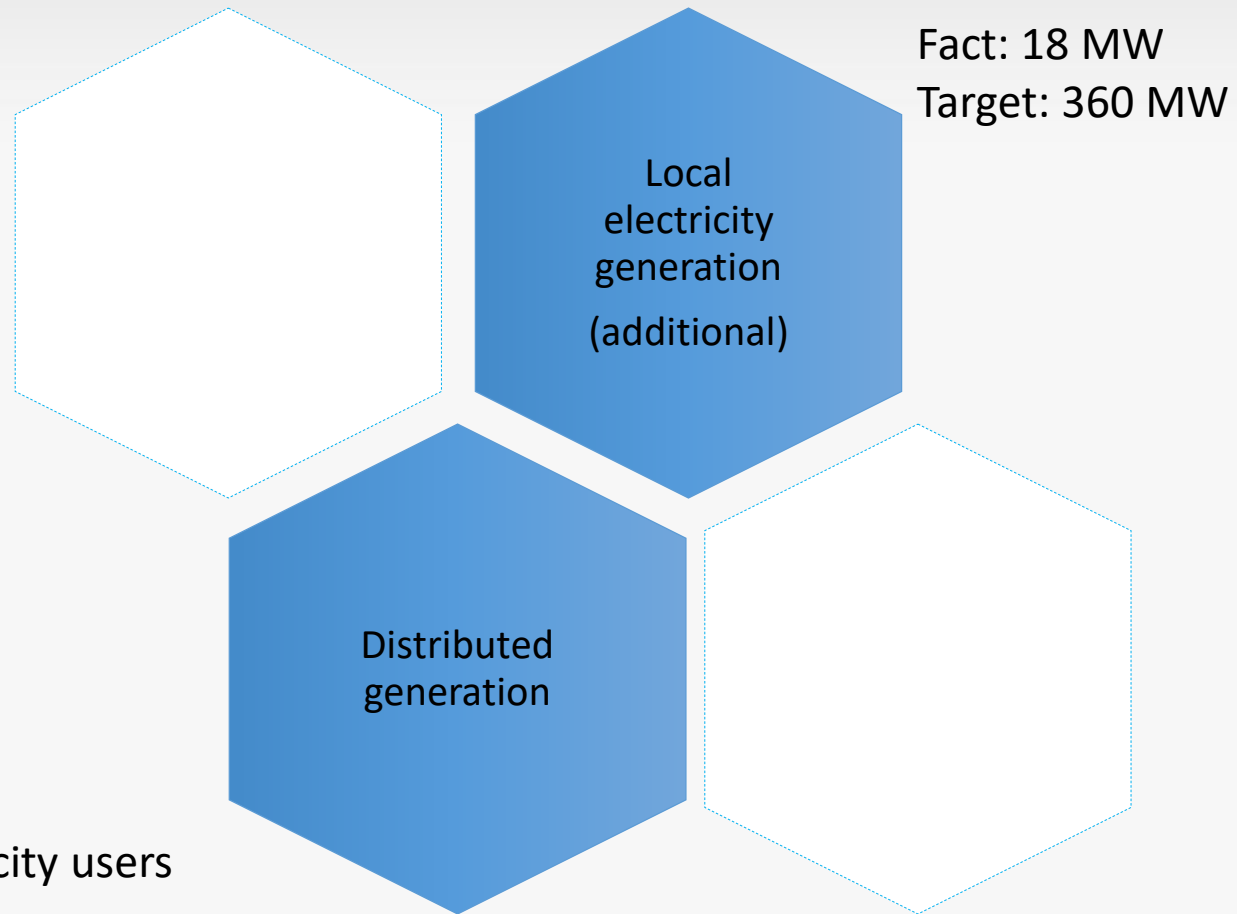

Main goals in **2012**:

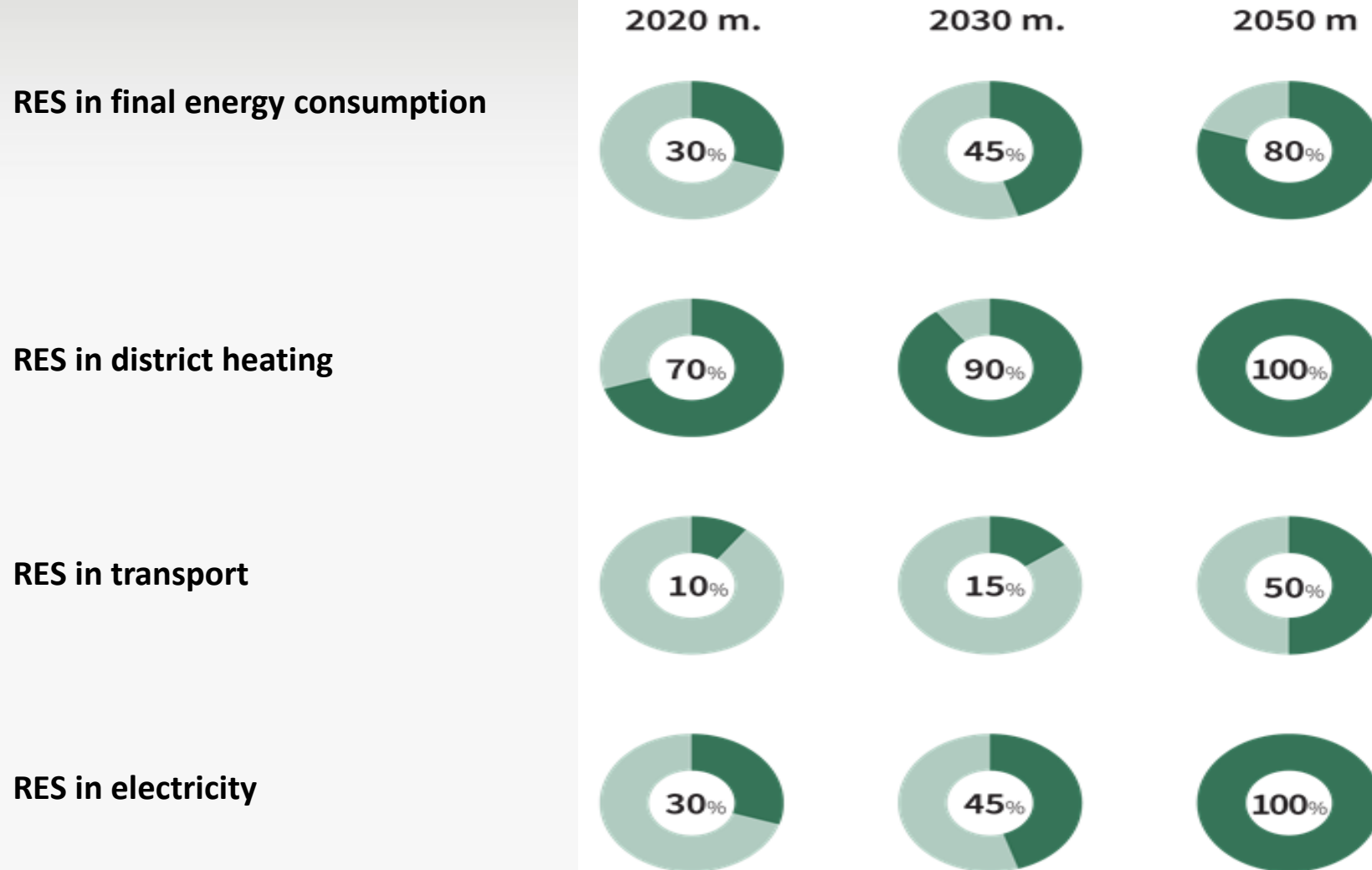
- *energy security*
